### **Jaclyn Chasse, N.D.**

Dr. Jaclyn Chasse is the founder of Perfect Fertility, a fertility-focused tele-consult practice. She graduated from Bastyr over 10 years ago, grew a large family practice before shifting to the exclusive specialty area of fertility.
